

## HTML, Part 2: Creating a Form

1. In **Firefox**, open the following URL: [tinyurl.com/htmlformcomplete](http://tinyurl.com/htmlformcomplete).
2. Click **Fork** (IMPORTANT, YOU MUST DO THIS!). Click the x in the CSS and JS panels on the right to close them. Click the bottom-right icon to change the panel layout. Adjust the size of the HTML panel to fit your preferences.
3. In the HTML panel, create a first-level heading with the text "Practice Form."
4. Immediately below that, create a form. Apply the method= attribute with a value of "post". Apply the action= attribution with a value of "submit.php".
5. Inside the form, create 13 sibling <div> elements for your questions to go in.
6. Using the **appropriate input types**, create the following form fields:
  - a. First Name
  - b. Last Name
  - c. Password
  - d. Birthdate
  - e. E-mail Address
  - f. Phone Number
  - g. Favorite Color
  - h. Pick a Number (1 to 10)
  - i. Preferred Dinner Time
  - j. Academic Status (Dropdown: Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, Senior)
  - k. Gender (Radio: Female or Male)
  - l. Browser(s) Owned (Checkbox: IE, Firefox, Chrome, Safari, Opera)
  - m. Comments
7. Add labels for each field with appropriate name/for pairs and label text.
8. Add autofocus to the first field. Make the following fields required (client-side validation): a, b, c, e, and f.
9. Add asterisks by adding a class= attribute with a value of "required" to the <div> elements for the fields listed in #8.
10. Add placeholder text of "xxx-xxx-xxxx" for phone number and "user@domain.com" for e-mail address.
11. Create a submit button with the <button> element. Have the button text be "Click here to submit!"
12. Check your work against the following URL: [tinyurl.com/htmlformcomplete](http://tinyurl.com/htmlformcomplete). Fill out the form!
