

HTML, Part 2: Creating a Table

1. In **Firefox**, open the following URL: tinyurl.com/htmltableblank.
2. Click **Fork** (IMPORTANT, YOU MUST DO THIS!). Click the x in the CSS and JS panels on the right to close them. Click the bottom-right icon to change the panel layout. Adjust the size of the HTML panel to fit your preferences.
3. In the HTML panel, create a first-level heading with the text “Practice Table.”
4. Immediately below that, create a table. Give it an id= attribute with a value of “pricing”.
5. Inside the table, create 8 rows and 5 columns. The first row should contain header cells and the rest body cells.
6. Input the first row’s cells as follows: blank, Free, Basic, Premium, Enterprise.
7. Input the second row’s cells as follows: Price, \$0 / month, \$10 / month, \$50 / month, Request a quote. Hyperlink “Request a quote” to my website (egsnider.com).
8. Input the third row’s cells as follows: Users, 1, 10, 50, Unlimited.
9. Input the fourth row’s cells as follows: Dashboards, 1, 3, 5, Unlimited.
10. Input the fifth row’s cells as follows: Custom CSS, no-icon, yes-icon, yes-icon, yes-icon. The “no-icon” is an image located at egsnider.com/no.png and should have alt text of “No.” The “yes-icon” is an image located at egsnider.com/yes.png and should have alt text of “Yes”.
11. Input the sixth row’s cells as follows: IP Restriction, no-icon, yes-icon, yes-icon, yes-icon.
12. Input the seventh row’s cells as follows: Custom Domain, no-icon, no-icon, yes-icon, yes-icon.
13. Input the eighth row’s cells as follows: 24/7 Customer Service, no-icon, no-icon, no-icon, yes-icon.
